

Please note the Garden is set in a small valley and therefore it is not ideal for wheelchairs. We recommend two people to push. Suitable electric wheelchairs can navigate parts of the grounds. However we do not allow 3 wheel electric chairs as they are not sufficiently stable.

Feel free to follow your own route but our suggestion is as follows. On entering the Garden through the arch at the back of the walled garden, turn right and follow the upper path to the top of the valley. Continue along the serpentine path. You can visit the maze via the side path or the flower garden in front of the white Gothic screen.

Continue anti clockwise behind the beech hedge and Plunge Pool. The path will then take you to the Tunnel Arbour. Follow on with the pond on your left. You can now head back via the steep slope to the exit.

If you find the path at the end too daunting you could return across the grass during drier periods or backtrack the way you have come.

Although there is a short slope up to the Maze, the maze itself is flat.

This part of the route is a woodchip path and quite steep

This is the steepest slope so be careful.

You are starting here.

We cannot recommend this area for wheelchairs

This area has soft surface paths and not really suitable for wheelchairs
